




Itinerary

Day 1: 02 Jul (Sat) Sydney ✈ Hong Kong ✈ Nanjing

Today you will fly with Cathay Pacific Airways flight **CX162 1005/1750** from Sydney to Hong Kong, then connect the flight **KA862 1855/2125** onto Nanjing, CBT tour guide and coach will meet you at the airport and transfer you to Nanjing Fangyuan Jinling Plaza Hotel 4* for 2 nights.

Day 2: 03 Jul (Sun) Nanjing

Meal: B/L/D

Today you will have a day tour in Nanjing, visit the Ming Tombs, Dr. Sun Yet Sun's Memorial, and Confucius Temple and the market, after dinner transfer back to the hotel.

Day 3: 04 Jul (Mon) Nanjing ➡ Danyang

Meal: B

Today we will transfer you to Dan Yang Senior High School (丹阳高级中学), which is about 1.5 hour drive, upon arrival check into Dan Yang Jinhao International Hotel 4* for 2 nights.

Day 4: 05 Jul (Tue) Danyang

Meal: B

Study at sister school.

Day 5: 06 Jul (Wed) Nanjing ✈ Xian

Meal: B/L/D

Today you will fly to Xian with **MU2769 0850/1055**, Xian is the most historical city in China, it used to be the capital of ancient China for 11 dynasties. Afternoon tour to the Big Wild Goose Pagoda and its Square. You spend two nights in Xian Days Inn & Suite Xinxing Hotel 4*

Day 6: 07 Jul (Thu) Xian

Meal: B/L/D

Today you visit the "Terracotta Warriors". They are found at an archaeological site which so far has yielded some 8000 ancient terra cotta soldiers and horses, each a unique, finely detailed sculpture. An afternoon tour to Ancient City Wall, where you can ride bikes. Dinner is served as a delicious dumpling banquet and followed by a spectacular Tang Dynasty Show.



Day 7: 08 Jul (Fri) Xian ➡ Beijing

Meal: B/L/D

Morning tour to the Tang Museum where students could enjoy a Chinese Calligraphy lecture and learn how to write Chinese using traditional brush and ink, afternoon transfer to the Railway Station for the Bullet train **G666 1600/2131** to Beijing (dinner will be take away from KFC), met and transferred to the Beijing Penta Hotel 4* for 3 nights.

Day 8: 09 Jul (Sat) Beijing

Meal: B/L/D

Today you visit Tiananmen Square, the largest City Square in the world. From Tiananmen Square, visitors enter the gates of the Forbidden City. This massive complex was the centre of the Ming and Qing dynasties. With almost 10,000 rooms, this remarkable, well-preserved imperial palace is the largest palace in the world. After lunch, you take trishaw ride to visit the Hutongs, which is an ancient city alley, to experience the life of the local people.



Day 9: 10 Jul (Sun) Beijing

Meal: B/L/D

Today you visit the Great Wall of China. This is the pride of China and one of the Seven Wonders of the World. It is one of the most amazing man-made structures. After climbing the Great Wall, you visit the Summer Palace which is the largest and best preserved of all the imperial palace gardens, and boasts such delights as the "Marble Boat" and the ornately painted "Long Corridor". You then head off to the 2008 Beijing Olympic venues of the Bird's Nest and Water Cube for a photo stop. Enjoy the Beijing Duck dinner tonight.

Day 10: 11 Jul (Mon) Beijing ➡ Shanghai

Meal: B/L/D

Today you will take the High Speed Train to Shanghai, met and have a day tour in Shanghai, Today you will visit the new district across from the Bund called Pudong to experience the economic booming of China and the landmark of Shanghai – The Oriental Pearl TV Tower, where you get a bird's eye view of the city. In the afternoon you will visit Yu

Yuan Garden, a classical Ming Dynasty garden with pavilions, towers, and terraces then followed by the Chenghuangmiao bazaar. Stay at Shanghai Sunrise on the Bund Hotel 4* for 2 nights.

Day 11: 12 Jul (Tue) Shanghai

Meal: B/L/D

Morning tour Then the Bund and Nanjing Road, Shanghai Museum, afternoon walking around Xintiandi, the old Shanghai, after dinner you will watch the famous Shanghai Acrobatic Show at Grand Circuit.

Day 12: 13 Jul (Wed) Shanghai ✈ Hong Kong

Meal: B/L

Today we'll take you to do shopping at Taobao Market, in the evening you will take the flight **CX369 1735/2015** to Hong Kong, the guide will meet you at Hong Kong airport and transfer you to Ramada Hotel Kowloon for 2 nights.

Day 13: 14 Jul (Thu) Hong Kong

Today is at your leisure.

Day 14: 15 Jul (Fri) Hong Kong ✈ Sydney

Meal: B

Today is at leisure, in the evening, you will be picked up from the hotel and transfer to the airport for the flight **CX101 departing at 23:55** back to Sydney.

Arrive in Sydney at 1050 in the morning.
