

**Day1: 20 Jul 2018 Siem Reap – Arrival** (This dinner with show is buffet there are many choices to select even you're vegetarian)

14:00pm: This Afternoon, we start our tour to enjoy the boat cruise on the Great [Lake of Tonle Sap](#) at [Kampong Phluk](#), its extraordinary bio-diversity and hydrology make it an ecological wonder of the world, offer visitors an insight into the old tradition of riparian life and natural splendour of Cambodia. On the way back, stop to have a look at the fishing villages which dot the semi-submerged forest that lines the flood plain rim of the lake, offering an excellent place to see lakeside rural Cambodia.

At 18:00pm: after a short refreshment at your hotel, we continue to our Restaurant for Welcome Dinner with Apsara Dance show at local restaurant. *For those travellers thirsting for cultural highlights of Cambodia, no visit to Cambodia is complete without attending at least one traditional Khmer dance performance, often referred to as 'Apsara Dance' after one of the most popular Classical dance pieces. Traditional Khmer dance better described as 'dance-drama' in that the dances are not merely dance but also meant to convey a story or message.*

**Day2: 21 Jul 2018 Siem Reap – Angkor Exploration** (All tourist have to walk from 1 temple to other temple our bus will stop nearby temple area)

08:00am: After breakfast at your hotel, we begin our tours to: [The ancient capital of Angkor Thom \(12th century\)](#) See the [South Gate, Bayon Temple](#) – unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara, [Baphuon temple](#) lying just to the north of Bayon a pyramidal representation of mythical Mont Meru. We step to see our old palace as [Phimeankas](#) temple in huge complex that was used for our king in the past time [Then Elephant terrace](#) is platform for king and officer viewed show and people meeting. [Preah Palilay](#) was is older than Angkor Thom was nearby, deeply in forest and on path back You see monk sprinkle water to people. Lunch by your own at local restaurant

15:00pm: We continue our visit to the famous [temple: Angkor Wat](#). Angkor Wat is a World Heritage Site since 1992, famous for its beauty and splendour. Angkor Wat features the longest continuous bas-relief in the world, which runs along the outer gallery walls and narrates stories from Hindu mythology. Come back to your hotel and overnight in Siem Reap

**Day3: 22 Jul 2018 Cooking Class & Phare Circuses performance**

09.30 am: Welcoming and Introduction with coffee & tea with our Chef (trainer) and discuss about the program.

The participants will take tour to Siem Reap morning market. Our chef will advise the participants and guide in discovering the Cambodian fruits, vegetables, fishes without forgetting the multi-colour spices and herbs.

10.30 am: Arrival back at Our [Eco-Tourism Site](#) (OES)/or Empress Angkor Hotel where refreshing drinks and cold towels are waiting for you. Let's move on to the kitchen to start the class with theory. A full three courses Khmer menu will be prepared by you, all under professional guidance by our skilled Khmer chefs.

12.30 pm: Your self-made lunch will be served in our Love Bridge at Our Eco-Tourist Site/Empress Angkor and includes mineral water, a glass of house-wine and coffee or tea. Upon completion of the Class all "students" will receive our Empress Cooking Class Apron, an Empress [Khmer Cooking Class Certificate](#), a Menu-card with the prepared menu and to relax afterwards; you have all-day free access to green view of OES.

At 20:00pm: after a short refreshment at your hotel, we continue to [Circus Uniquely Cambodian](#), Daringly Modern and This show take about 1 hour.

This is a Siem Reap's most unique, authentic, top rated evening entertainment. More than just a circus, pare performers use theatre, music, dance and modern circus arts to tell uniquely Cambodian stories; historical, folk and modern. The young circus artists will astonish you with their energy, emotion, enthusiasm and talent. Transfer to local restaurant and have dinner with your own acc. Overnight in Siem Reap

**Day4: 23 Jul 2018 Angkor Centre for Conservation, Landmine and Banteay Srei Temple.** (tour take about 5hours include visit and travelling)

08:30am: After breakfast at your hotel, we begin our tours to visit Landmine Museum the Cambodian Landmine Museum was established in 1997 by ex-child soldier Aki Ra. After years of fighting he returned to the villages in which he planted thousands of mines and began removing them, by hand, and defusing them with homemade tools.

Drive to the intricately carved and well-preserved Banteay Srei. The detailed reliefs on this smaller sandstone structure are regarded as the finest, most skilfully crafted in Cambodia. Banteay Srei has only been accessible since the late 1990s, when the Khmer Rouge left the area. Lunch at the temple (own expense), and a short rest.

13:00pm Continue the Angkor Centre for Conservation of Biodiversity (ACCB), located near the Kbal Spean, is the first nature conservation centre in Cambodia. The ACCB aims to contribute to the conservation of wildlife and biodiversity in Cambodia. Come back to your hotel and overnight in Siem Reap

#### **Day5: 24 Jul 2018 Departure to Phnom Penh – Free leisure at your own time.**

Pick up from your hotel in Siem Reap at your departure time then fly to Phnom Penh. (Pick up and transfer rate already mention in our previous email)

#### **Day6: 25 Jul 2018 Genocide Museum & Sunset Cruise**

08:00am: After breakfast at your hotel, [Visit Tuol Sleng prison \(Genocide Museum\)](#) was the most secret organ of the Khmer Rouge regime. S-21 stands for "Security Office 21." Was Angkor's premier security institution specifically designed for the interrogation and extermination of anti-Angkor elements.

16:45pm pick up by our bus from Hotel can be arranged, pick up times will be confirmed to ensure the boat can leave promptly for 5pm. or larger groups can arrive at the dock area where they will be met by the guide and escorted onto the boat. ([Start from 17:00pm to 18:30pm](#))

Step aboard the Mekong as we set off down the Tonle River taking in the sights of the city from a different perspective, enjoying the breeze away from the noise and heat of Phnom Penh. We sail down past the Royal Palace and the banks of Phnom Penh riverside watching the sunset over the city as we are turning around into the Mekong River at 3 river junctions

There we pass some of the floating villages passing fishing boats, farms and seeing another side of Cambodia that seems far removed from life in Phnom Penh. We then slowly cruise back seeing the city transform as it lights up in neon ready for the nightlife to swing into action. All this is from the comfort of the top decks of the boat enjoying dinner with set menu included.

#### **Day7: 26 Jul 2018 Half Day Silk Island Tour ([Tour totally take about 3hour+](#))**

08:00am: After breakfast at your hotel then transfer to the cruise for our half day tour to Silk island. Escape the city for a scenic about 3-hours cruise to the Silk Island from Phnom Penh, Sail past the floating villages and fishing farms of the Mekong River, on-board. After docking on the island, get a taste of local life as you visit the temples, silk plantations and villages, then learn about the island's silk production as you tour a silk farm.

Lunch will be provided by Set Menu and the person who eat vegetarian our chef will arrange as vegetarian food for them.

#### **Day8: 27 Jul 2018 Phnom Penh – Departure to Ho Chi Minh**

Transfer from hotel to airport for flight to HCMC.
